CDCC INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUPERVISION OF NOVICE SHOOTERS

Under guidelines set by the Police and CDCC, the following procedures are to be used when introducing novices to shooting at this Club.

- 1. The Novice is to be briefed on the safety aspects:
 - a. The correct mounting of the gun is to be advised and stressed by the supervising member.
 - b. When loading takes place the trigger finger is to be well clear of the trigger.
 - c. Should the gun not fire on the depression of the trigger, the Novice is to hold the gun securely pointing in a safe direction downwards for 30 seconds as if the gun may fire.
 - d. After 30 seconds, the supervising member/instructor is to remove the gun from the novice and unload in a careful manner.
 - e. Should the gun misfire (faulty cartridge) then the barrels are to be checked prior to handing the gun back to the novice.
- 2. The novice is not to hold any ammunition during the round. The supervising member is to load the gun only when the novice is in a safe position in the cage.
 - a. Only one cartridge is to be loaded into the correct barrel for the novice at a time.
 - b. When the Supervising member is satisfied the novice is safe, the novice will be permitted to fire a pair.
- 3. The supervising member is to be in a position to be able to take immediate control of the gun within the cage.
